



### New Delhi World Schools Debate Academy

The New Delhi World Schools Debate
Academy is modelled after the international
World Schools Debate Academy in Slovenia,
which was established by the Slovenian
national debate organisation *Za in proti*,
zavod za kulturo dialoga/Pro et contra,
Institute for the Culture of Dialogue, and
organised in cooperation with World Debate
Institute at University of Vermont, USA.

It has quickly become renowned as a training event for World Schools Debate Format, well-known globally for its rigorous and student-centred training approach, as well as for its development of new curricula and exercises that benefit numerous debate programs.

WSDA has been going strong since 2008, and has welcomed more than 2000 students and teachers from 50+ countries from all over the globe. The training is very intense, with a lot of interactive practice in small groups with excellent trainers, including Chief Adjudicators of European and World Schools Debating Championships.

All the trainers have extensive experience as debaters with numerous competitive successes as well as significant experience as trainers at both national and international levels. Each of them has served as trainers at the World Schools Debate Academy (WSDA) and various other debate training programs across Europe and Asia.

### FORMAT OF WSD TRAINING

The training part of the New Delhi WSDA brings lectures, exercises, debate and content electives and practice debates. Short debate theory lectures (argumentation, refutation, case building, strategy, role of the speakers, type of the debate motions, points of information, public speaking) will be followed by exercises to have hands on experience. The final event is going to be a debate tournament where debaters in teams of 4 debate against each other about different exciting and important topics.

The sessions will be mentored by Chief Adjudicators of European and World Schools Debating Championships. All the trainers have incredible body of work to their credit.

## Instructions for the World School Debate Training:

Participants are scheduled for a rigorous training from October 5 to October 10, from 9 AM to 5 PM.

Each participant shall receive **45 hours** of intensive coaching. Registration is mandatory via the provided link.

Additionally, for every group of ten participants from a school, one accompanying teacher shall receive complementary training.

# Fee Structure and Mode of Payment

For in-house registration (Millennium Schools), the fee is set at ₹30,000 or \$359.20, encompassing training, stationery, breakfast, lunch, and high tea.

External participation incurs a fee of ₹32,000 or \$383.14, covering stationery, breakfast, lunch, and high tea.

Payment is to be facilitated exclusively through online channels.

# Instructions for Teachers' Training


- Schedule: The training for teachers will commence on 7th October, with sessions running from 9:00 AM onwards.
- Curriculum Overview: The training program will encompass a comprehensive curriculum designed to enhance debate adjudication skills, and effective mentorship techniques.
- Participation: Each participating school may nominate one accompanying teacher to partake in the training sessions.

- Registration: Teachers must complete the registration process through the provided online portal before the deadline.
- Accommodation: For outstation teachers, accommodation arrangements can be made upon request. Kindly inform the organizing committee in advance to facilitate arrangements.
- Training Materials: All necessary training materials will be provided to participants upon registration.
- Engagement: Active participation and engagement in all training sessions are encouraged to maximise the learning experience.

# Guidelines for Outstation Participants

- Accommodation Request: Outstation
  participants requiring lodging during the
  event may avail accommodation facilities
  provided by the organising committee upon
  request.
- Additional Payment: A nominal fee of ₹15,000 or \$179.60 will be charged for the provision of food (Dinner for all six days) and accommodation facilities, ensuring convenience and comfort throughout the duration of the event.
- Booking Procedure: Participants must indicate their requirement for accommodation during the registration process and make the additional payment accordingly.

- Accommodation Details: The provided lodging will include comfortable amenities and facilities to ensure a pleasant stay for the participants near the event venue. To and fro transport will be provided for outstation participants, ensuring convenient commuting between their hotel and the training venue.
- Deadline: Please ensure accommodation requests and payments are made before the specified deadline to guarantee availability and seamless arrangements.
- Confirmation: Upon receipt of payment, participants will receive confirmation of their accommodation booking along with further details regarding their stay.
- Cancellation Policy: Kindly note that accommodation and registration fees are nonrefundable after the specified deadline.

Barbara has an extensive background in debate, with nearly 15 years of experience that includes debating at the high school and university levels, and judging debate tournaments, including the World Schools Debate Championship in Zagreb.

She has also coached the Turkish national debate team for several years. Barbara represented the University of Ljubljana at the World Universities Debating Championship in Malaysia. She was the national university debate champion and lectured at debate academies

in Slovenia, China, Turkey, Italy, Poland and Greece.

She is currently the president of the board of directors at Za in proti.

Rok Hafner is associated with **Za in Proti**, the Slovenian national debate organisation. He is responsible for the national high school debate program and European projects. Rok has been highly instrumental in conducting trainings for different audiences in Slovenia and other countries.



She was a member of the Slovenian national team at the WSDC 2019 in Thailand. As a judge, Jurneja

has broken at many prestigious international tournaments such as the Harvard Invitationals and the Winter Holidays Open, Europe's biggest debate competition, where she has judged the finals several year in a row.
